## Resolution In Support of Habeas Corpus

**WHEREAS**, the right of habeas corpus – that is the right of any human being detained for any reason to be brought before a judge or court – is fundamental to our democracy,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the San Francisco Labor Council Delegate Body urges our U.S. Senators Boxer and Feinstein and our U.S. House of Representatives Pelosi and Lantos to oppose any and all attacks on the right of habeas corpus, and urges them to individually and collectively oppose such provision in the current 2006 Defense Appropriations Bill.
