## Resolution Endorsing the California Health Care Coalition (CHCC)

WHEREAS, health care costs continue to rise without effective restraint amid strong evidence of widespread waste, poor quality, and opportunistic pricing in our health industry, and

WHEREAS, health benefit costs drain away funds urgently needed for jobs, wages, pensions, and health coverage for the uninsured in public and private sectors of our economy, and

WHEREAS, health care costs in San Francisco, Marin, and San Mateo counties are among the highest in California and the nation, while the quality of care available in our communities is uneven and often well below what the art and science of medicine can achieve,

WHEREAS, the California Health Care Coalition represents 3 million Californians and is showing the way for labor and management to work together to improve and assure the quality and fair pricing of health services by combining the strengths of many organizations locally and statewide,,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Executive Committee of the San Francisco Labor Council endorses and supports the California Health Care Coalition (CHCC) and urges every union, union employer, and labor-management purchasing organization to join CHCC and participate fully in local programs to improve the quality and cost of health care in our city and county, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Executive Committee of the San Francisco Labor Council call upon the City and County of San Francisco to reaffirm their long term support and endorsement by joining the California Health Care Coalition, thus adding their substantial strength to those of 45 other employers, unions trust funds, and local agencies, and thereby strengthening CHCC's role in strategies to improve the quality and affordability of health care in San Francisco and throughout California.
