Statement Regarding Civil Service Reform

The San Francisco Labor Council, AFL-CIO opposes Mayor Gavin Newsom's efforts to circumvent the Meet and Confer obligation between the City of San Francisco and the Public Employee Unions regarding Civil Service reform.

The delegates to the San Francisco Labor Council support the Public Employee Unions in their effort to make appropriate changes to the civil service system through the Meet and Confer process.

The San Francisco Labor Council will continue to be on record in favor of a merit system, instead of cronyism in the hiring and promotion and potential layoffs of city employees. Further, the Executive Director of the San Francisco Labor Council will report the action of this Council to Mayor Newsom and his staff.
