Resolution in Solidarity with UPTE CWA 9119, Local 1's Unfair Labor Practice Strike and Days of Action

Be it Resolved that the San Francisco Labor Council support the Unfair Labor Practice Strike on November 18-19, 2009 called by the University Professional and Technical Employees Local 9119 (UPTE CWA 9119, Local 1) at UC Berkeley by encouraging SFLC members and affiliates to walk the picket lines with our union sisters and brothers; and

Be it Further Resolved that the San Francisco Labor Council expresses its solidarity and active support for the November 18-20 days of action throughout the entire University of California system by staff, students and faculty who are protesting layoffs, furloughs, threats to pensions and benefits, severe and damaging cuts to academic and research programs, huge fee hikes which fall heavily on those students least able to pay and to the growing privatization of the University of California; and

Be it Finally Resolved that the San Francisco Labor Council encourage its members and affiliates to wherever possible, actively participate in the November 18-20, 2009 activities: join the UPTE picket lines at UC Berkeley or UC Office of the President (downtown Oakland); participate in the teach-ins and spread the solidarity about the walkout and the fight against the privatization of public education.
