Resolution in Support of “College not Combat”

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Labor Council strongly supported Proposition N, the policy statement on behalf of San Francisco residents in firm opposition to the Iraq War; and

WHEREAS, economic circumstances and active government policy make the young people of San Francisco and this nation potential cannon fodder for the war machine and the misadventures in Iraq and elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Labor Council supports real economic opportunity for young people and thus supports opposition to this predatory economic draft,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the San Francisco Labor Council give early endorsement to the initiative “College Not Combat,” and
