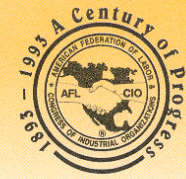

Resolution Regarding U.S. Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi and Her Position on the Iraq War

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Labor Council recognizes that U.S. Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi has made some movement on the issue of the U.S. occupation of Iraq; and

WHEREAS, her resolution asks President Bush to come up with a plan for success in Iraq that will bring the troops home; and

WHEREAS, it is highly unlikely that a president who led this nation into an illegal war based on lies, deception and manipulation leading to the deaths of tens of thousands of Iraqis and almost 2,000 U.S. troops will ever come up with a viable exit strategy; and

WHEREAS, Bay Area Congresswoman Barbara Lee last week submitted a resolution to Congress demanding the U.S. dismantle all its bases as it leaves; and

WHEREAS, Bay Area Congresswoman Lynn Woolsey has introduced a concrete plan to Congress to leave Iraq which speaks to reconstruction of Iraq and Iraq's sovereignty in all areas of life,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the SFLC set up a meeting as soon as possible with Congresswoman Pelosi to strongly encourage her to join these and other progressives to fight for a total and immediate withdrawal of the U. S. military from Iraq; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the SFLC endorse the national march against the war on September 24, 2005.
