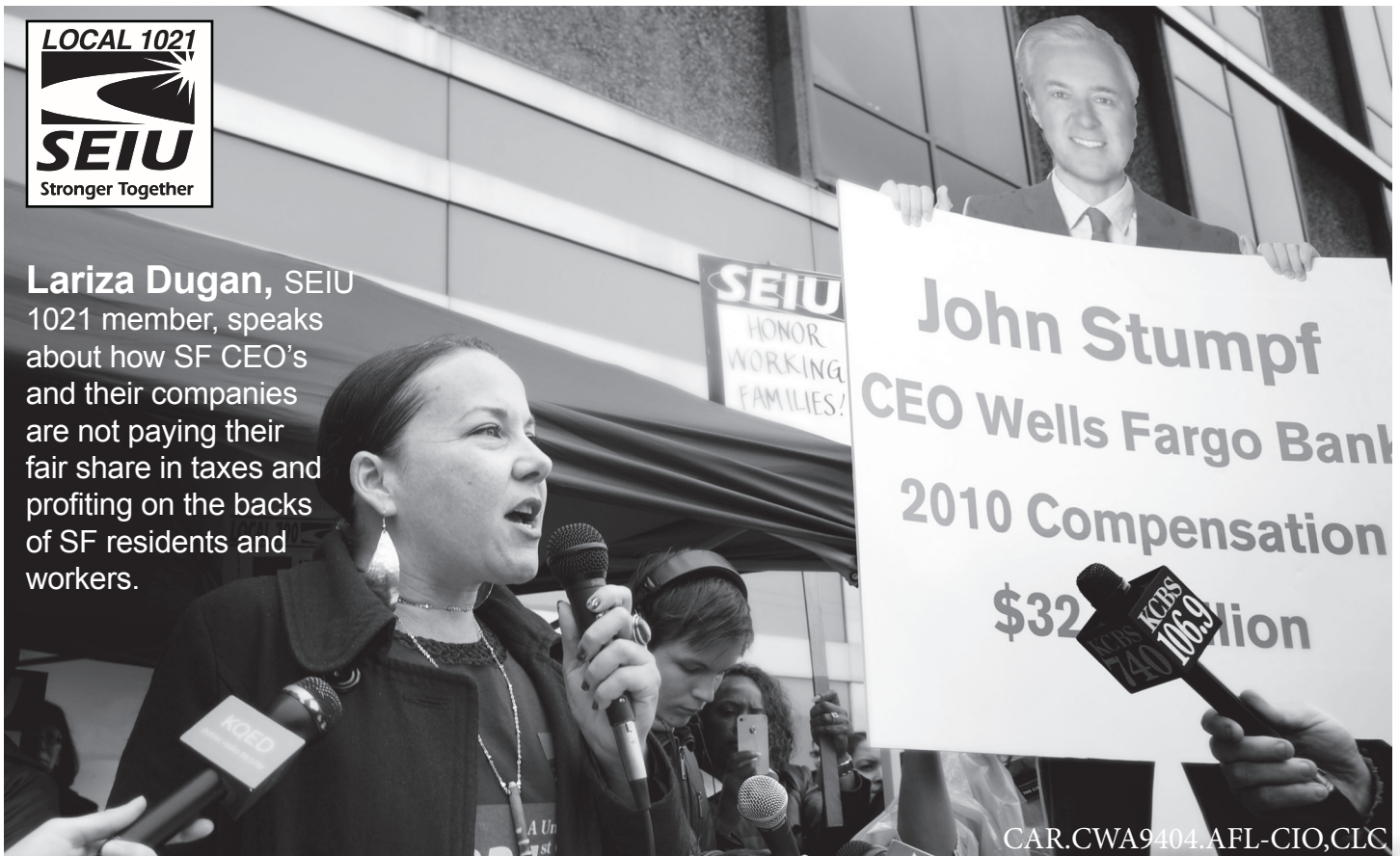

San Francisco residents, nurses, hospital and museum security officers, janitors, librarians and nonprofit workers of SEIU 1021 are angry that the City is shutting down clinics and community centers, cutting library hours and asking lowest paid city workers for more concessions to help close the city's projected \$170 million budget gap.
