We are the union members of the Pacific Media Workers Guild at the San Francisco Chronicle. We are the editors and reporters, librarians, graphic artists, office workers, salespeople, and much more. While our Union's negotiating team has presented proposals to Hearst Corp. in several meetings about our healthcare plan, Hearst Corporation negotiators have cancelled bargaining sessions FIVE times.

They are hoping the Union reaches a critical point — as the annual healthcare costs are about to rise, and our reserve operating funds run low — in order to pressure us to accept an abysmal healthcare package that is designed to DISCOURAGE our members from getting the care when we need it.

We believe the actions by Hearst, cancelling numerous meetings and refusing to negotiate in good faith, constitute Unfair Labor Practices by the company.

In the last two contracts that the Union signed with Hearst, in 2005 and 2009, the members sacrificed and accepted major concessions — layoffs of hundreds of employee/members, temporarily giving up seniority and arbitration rights, accepting cuts in pay and benefits — while management **retained** *its* benefits.
