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## PLEASE BRING:

- If you attended the June 29<sup>th</sup> or August 10<sup>th</sup> workshops and did not have a complete application: All your documents from those workshops.

All new attendees:

- Your green card, all current and expired passports, and two (2) passport-style photos.
- A list of your addresses and when you lived there, and your work and school history (last 5 years).
- A list of all trips and travel dates outside the U.S. since becoming a permanent resident.
- Information about your current spouse, ALL prior marriages for you and your spouse, and ALL your children (name, address, date/place of birth, date/place of marriage, SSN, immigration status and A#, if any).
- If you have been arrested: Bring ALL arrest and court documents, even if charges were dropped or record expunged.
- Application Filing Fee: Check or Money Order for **\$680.00** made out to **"US Department of Homeland Security"** (If 75 or older, only \$595), UNLESS you qualify for a fee waiver\*.
- \*Fee Waivers: If you cannot afford the filing fee, you may qualify for a fee waiver. You must bring documents such as pay stubs, tax return and/or recent written proof that you receive public benefits, like SSI, Medi-Cal, food stamps, WIC, CalWorks, cash aid, general assistance, etc.
- Men only: If you were living in the U.S. between the ages of 18 and 26, please bring evidence of Selective Service registration if you have it. You may verify registration at [www.sss.gov](http://www.sss.gov), or call (888) 655-1825.

### \* You may be eligible to not pay any fee to Immigration if:

- You receive public benefits (i.e. TANF, SSI, LINK, Medicaid)
- Your family earns 150% of the poverty level or less, according to the table below:

Number of people that live in your household	150 % poverty level
1	\$17,235
2	\$23,265
3	\$29,295
4	\$35,325
5	\$41,355
6	\$47,385
7	\$53,415
8	\$59,445
Add \$6,030 for each additional person	

- Or, you have special circumstances where you are not able to pay.
