

# Send a Message to AT&T and Alorica: Respect workers' rights at call centers in the Philippines!

Workers at AT&T vendor Alorica in the Philippines have organized a union to win better conditions. Now, they are facing severe union-busting from their management.

Join a protest to support workers' rights in the Philippines and tell AT&T that union-busting by its vendors is not acceptable to CWA members.

## **Protest at AT&T Flagship Store 1 Powell Street in San Francisco April 24, 12 to 1pm**

### **Background**

AT&T vendor Alorica – headquartered in Irvine, California – employs thousands of call center workers around the world, paying pennies on the dollar of what U.S. union workers earn.

CWA supports workers organizing to raise standards around the world so that our employers stop racing to the bottom.

In the Philippines, workers have organized a union, the **United Employees of Alorica** and gained legal recognition.

But management refuses to bargain and is trying to bust the union by terminating union members and bringing trumped up criminal charges against union officers.

In September 2018, the union filed a Notice of Strike and began planning a legally-protected strike to protest union-busting by Alorica. Since then, management has continued its campaign to break the union.

### **The United Employees of Alorica have the following demands:**

- 1) Drop the criminal charges filed against the union leaders
- 2) Reinstatement of the terminated officers of UEA
