



Resolution for Defending our Democracy Actions on November 4 and 7, 2020

Whereas, the San Francisco Labor Council passed a resolution that it will take whatever nonviolent actions are necessary to protect our democracy, and that it will begin communicating with its delegates, affiliates, and its allied labor organizations and progressive organizations upon passage of the resolution; and

Whereas, November 4, the day after Election Day, there are plans already in place for an action in San Francisco; and

Whereas, November 7 is considered a critical day for action because of indications that Trump may attempt to stop the counting of votes;

Therefore be it Resolved that the San Francisco Labor Council support the November 4 plans for a rally from 5:00-7:00 in front of City Hall, being led by Protect the Vote/Indivisible SF (see <https://www.facebook.com/events/2731730273771569/>) ; and

Be it Finally Resolved that the San Francisco Labor Council and its affiliate locals take the lead in organizing an action on November 7 with the understanding that between now and Election Day, we will focus our efforts and energy on GOTV, and will not divert resources or people-power from those efforts.
