Statement from SF Labor Council Executive Director Kim Tavaglione on the U.S. Supreme Court's Decision in the Case of Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization

Today's decision by the Supreme Court to overturn *Roe v. Wade* is an appalling attack on women's rights to access healthcare and control their own bodies and lives. Reproductive healthcare is inextricably linked to workers' rights and this decision will disproportionately affect low-wage workers, women of color, and immigrants.

This extreme and activist ruling by a conservative majority of the Supreme Court is alarming in its implication that other rights we hold dear, such as marriage equality and access to contraception, may be next to be stripped away from the American people.

The San Francisco labor movement will take this ruling as a call to action to educate our members on the vital importance of electing leaders who will protect and expand our rights and fight for economic, racial, and social equality. We are committed to making our voices heard at the ballot box and in our communities.
