***The San Francisco Labor Council Urges SFUSD School Board Member Ann Hsu to Resign***

The San Francisco Labor Council is calling upon School Board Member Ann Hsu to step down from her newly appointed position. Fresh off the recall from earlier this year, San Francisco cannot afford to get tied up in another racist scandal in our School District. Hsu, who was a leader in the recall effort, must abide by the same principles that she used against former school board members.

Her recently uncovered racist comments were completely shocking and unacceptable for any official charged with protecting and advocating for children and families in San Francisco. Her comments perpetuate false narratives and racist stereotypes and harm all San Francisco families.

At a time when the San Francisco Unified School District needs to work to rebuild and come together to fight against hate and protect all students, we cannot afford to have this kind of behavior on our school board. We as a Labor Movement stand for equity and against racism in all forms. In line with these standing principles, we appeal to Ann Hsu to not drag San Francisco into yet another controversial election and we ask for her to do the right thing and step down from her position.
